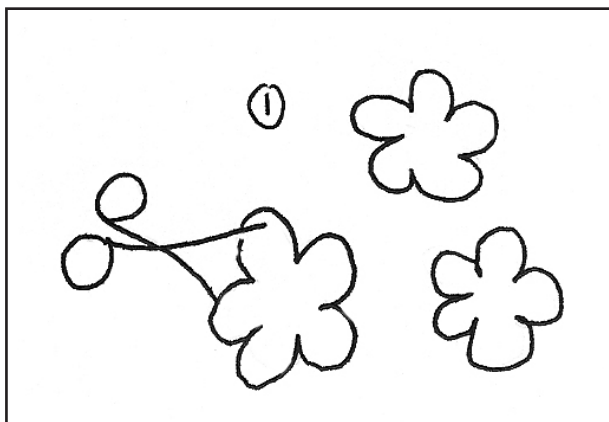
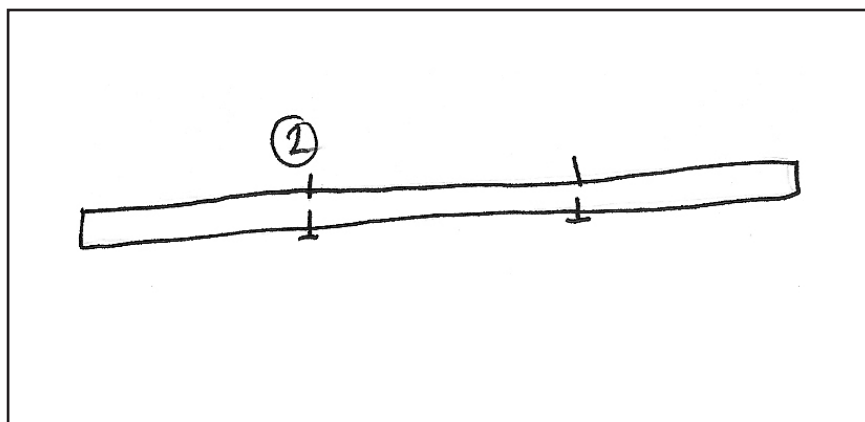


# flower necklace

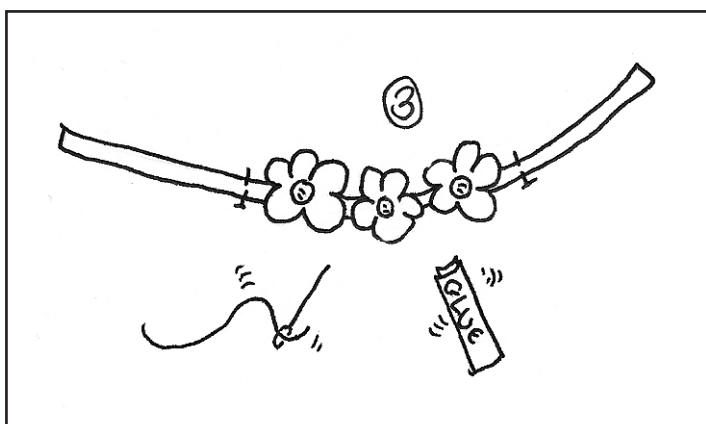
You will need: Fabric scraps (ones that don't fray, such as old t-shirts or other jerseys, felt, over-washed wool jumpers, blankets etc); 75cm length of ribbon, or a strip of another non-fraying fabric (this will make quite a short necklace); Needle and thread, or glue suitable for fabric use; Any beads, buttons etc you fancy; Scissors.



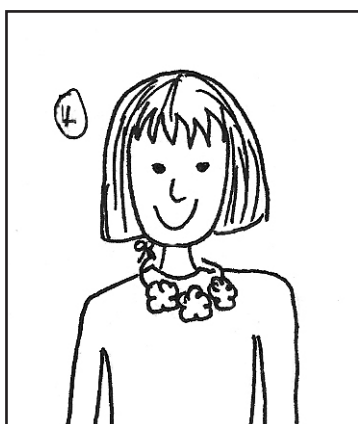
Cut flower shapes from the scrap fabric.



Measure about 25cm in from each end of the ribbon and mark with a pin. The centre section of the ribbon is where the flowers will go and the ends are for tying around your neck.



Sew or glue the fabric flowers to the centre section of the ribbon, decorating them with beads and buttons if you wish. Attach them to both sides of the ribbon so it can twist around.



Use the loose ends to tie it round your neck – remember to remove the pins first!!

## other ideas

- Different shapes (stars, animals)
- Make a bracelet or belt instead of a necklace
- Use the shapes you cut out to decorate bags, cushions, hairbands, clips or other items
