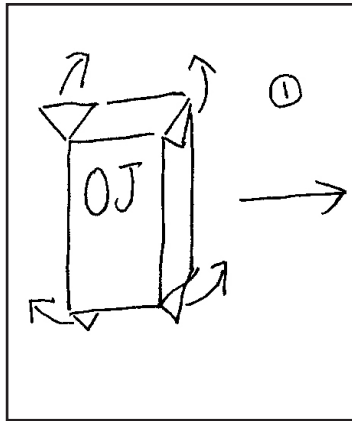


# tetra pak wallet

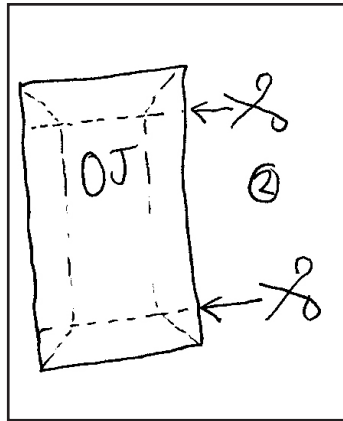
You will need: Empty, thoroughly cleaned Tetra Pak ("Tetra Brik" shape with wide front and narrow sides); Scissors; Ruler; Glue (UHU or similar); Hole punch; String or narrow ribbon.



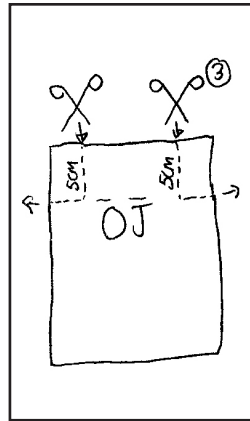

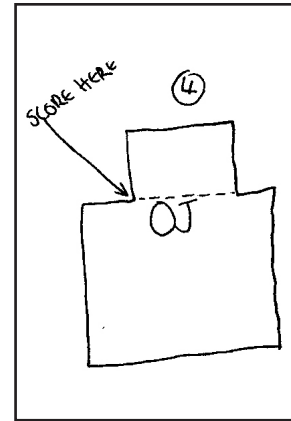
Unfold the flaps on the Tetra Pak and flatten it out.



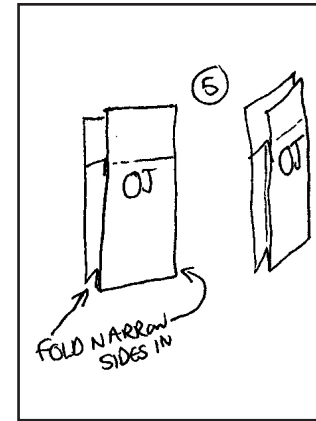
Neatly cut the top and bottom off the carton using the fold lines as a guide.



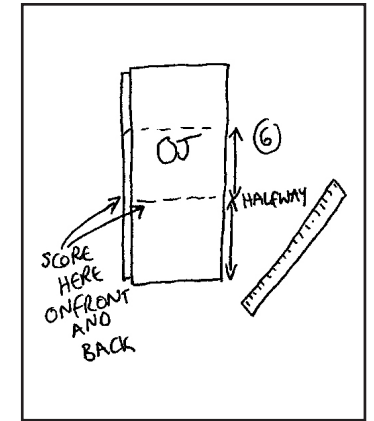
Cut away the top 5cm of the narrow sides.



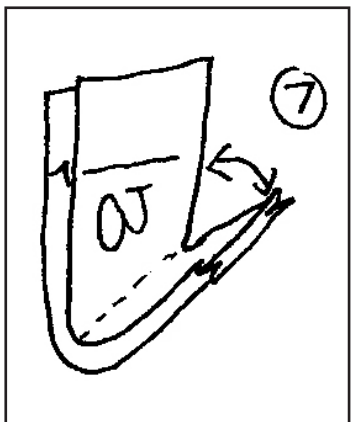
Where you have cut, score across the front and back (using ruler and blunt edge of scissors) to form two flaps.



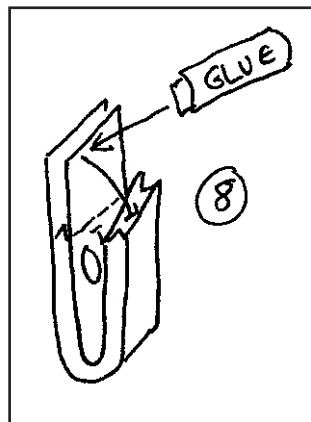
Fold the two narrow sides inwards in a V shape.



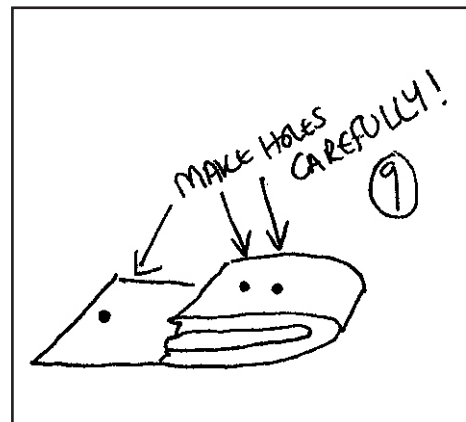
Measure half way between the cut edge at the bottom and the base of the flaps at the top and score across the carton on both sides.



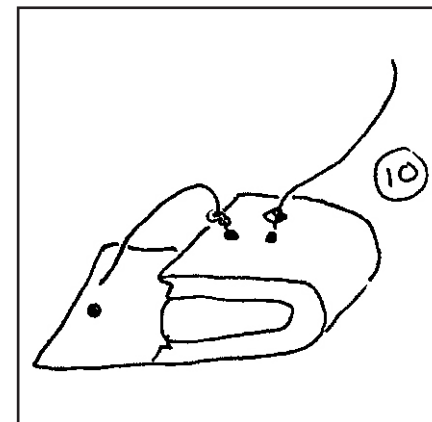
Fold the carton across the middle so that the cut edge at the bottom meets up with the base of the flaps.



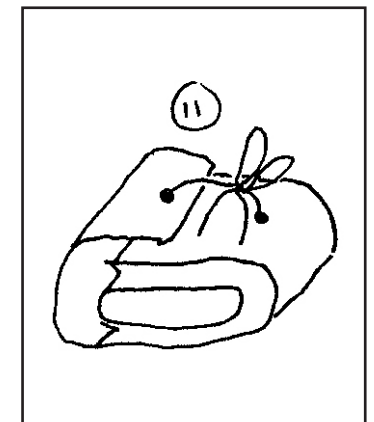
Fold the inside flap into the opening (the bottom of the carton) and secure with a dab of glue.



Make a hole in the outside flap with a hole punch or the point of the scissors – careful!! Then make two holes near each other on the surface beneath the flap.



Thread the string or ribbon through these two holes and knot it in place inside and outside, leaving two loose ends.



Thread one end through the hole in the flap, then tie it to the other end in a bow to keep the wallet shut.
